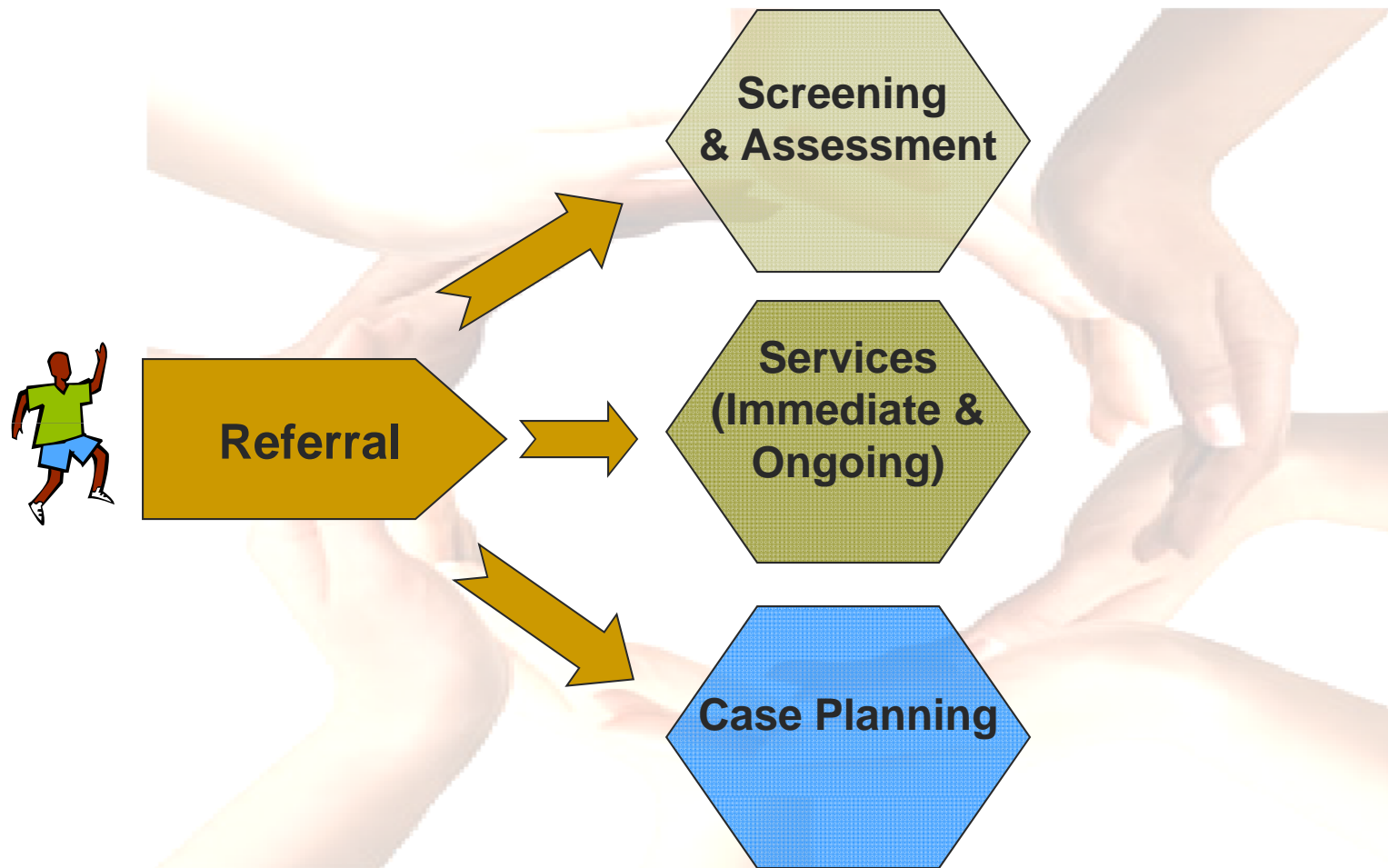

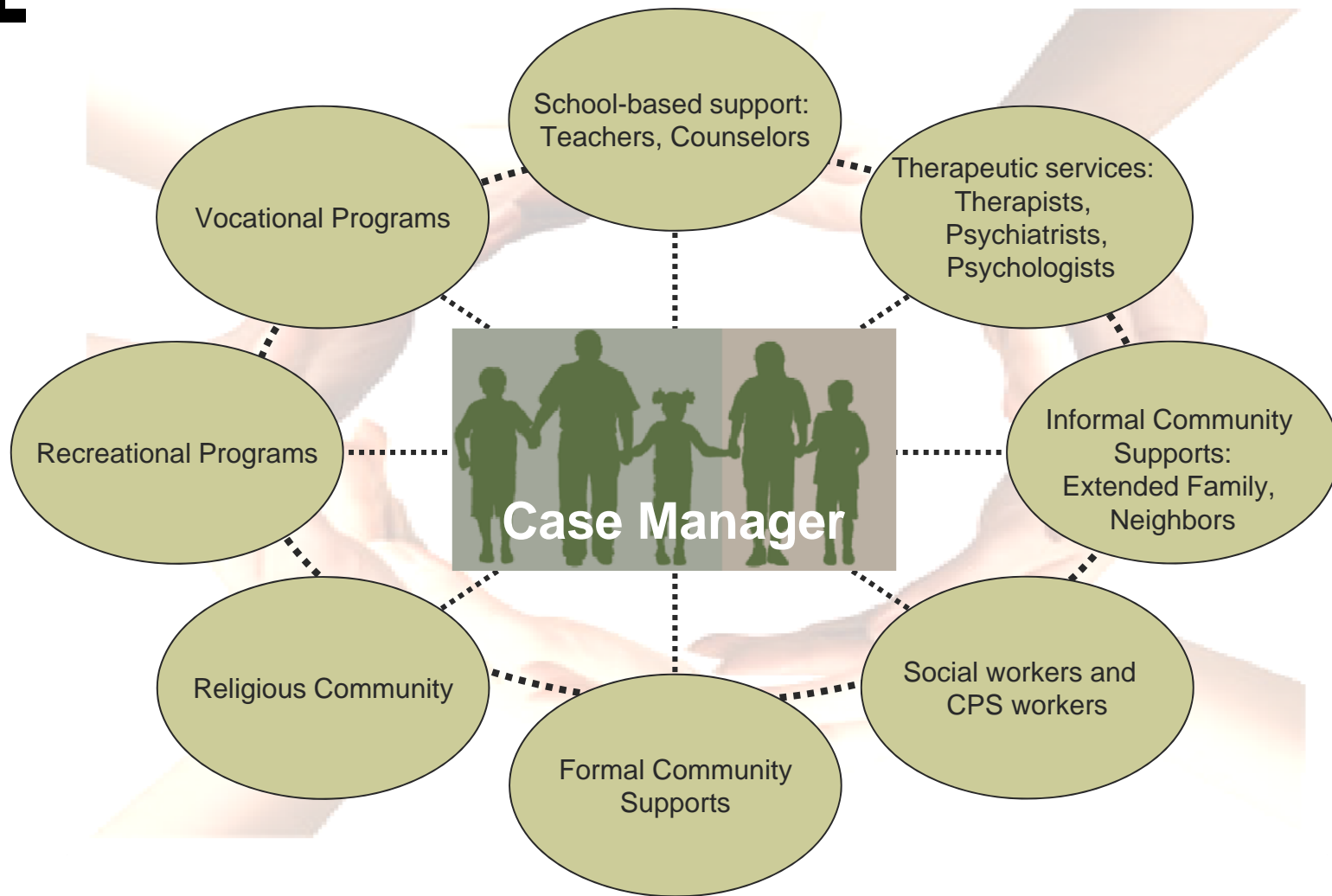

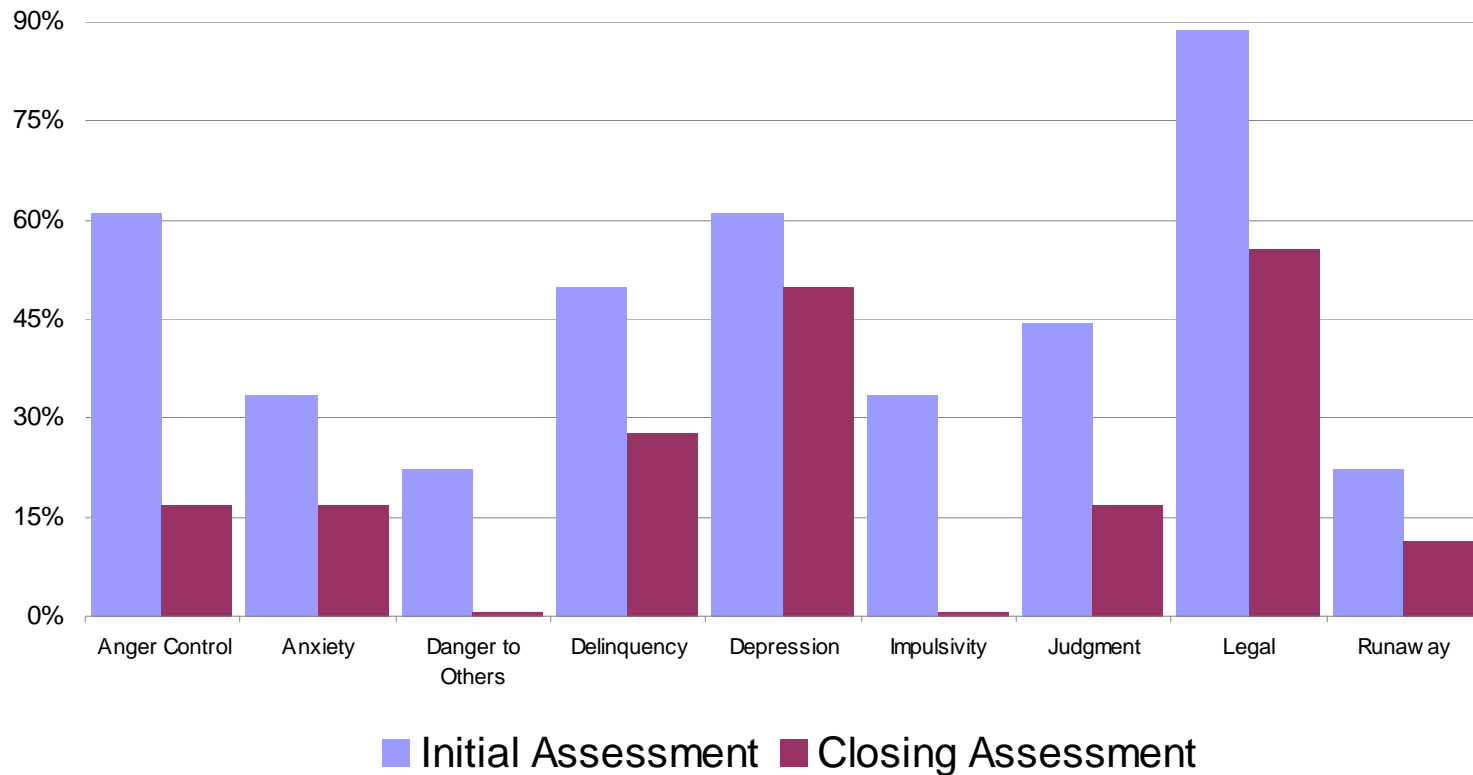
San Francisco's Unique Wraparound Model Utilizing a Coordinated Continuum of Care



Client's Community Support Network

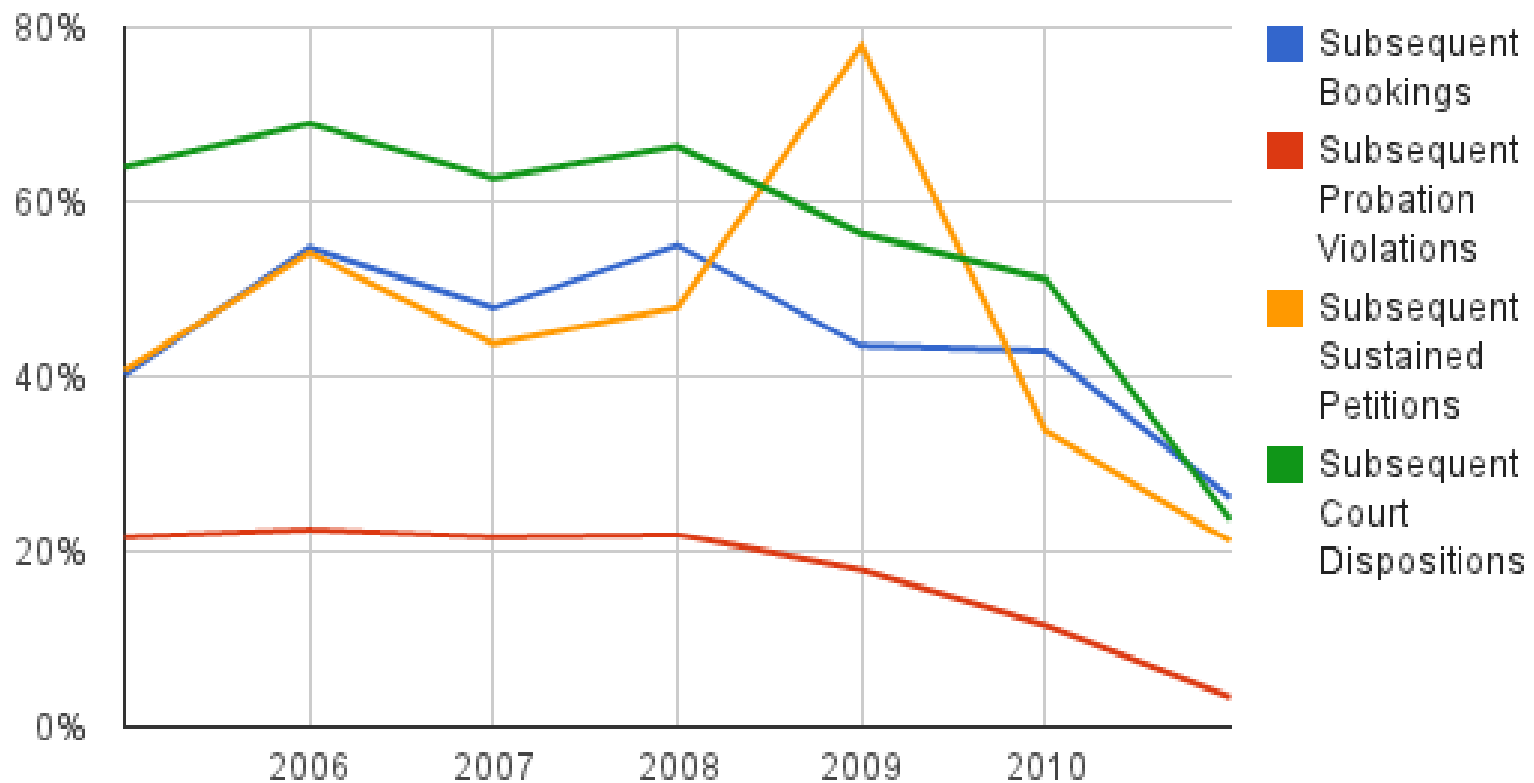


SF Wraparound Outcomes (FY 10-11)

How is San Francisco's Wraparound Program Funded?

EPSDT* Funds AND Wraparound Funds

- Often underutilized funding stream for justice-involved youth
 - Eligible Youth
 - Full-scope Medi-Cal
 - Medical necessity
 - Under age 21
 - Eligible Services
 - Eligible Provider
- Maximizing EPSDT allows for flexible use of Wraparound funds
 - Eligible Youth
 - Currently on probation
 - Stepping down from or at-risk of out-of-home placement

* Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, & Treatment

EPSDT & Wraparound Funding

How is EPSDT funded?

- Currently, EPSDT is funded 50% by the federal government, 45% by the state, and 5% by counties.
- As of July 1, 2012, EPSDT will be funded 50% by counties and 50% by the federal government.

How is WRAP funded?

- Currently, Wraparound is funded 60% by counties, and 40% by the state.
- As of July 1, 2012, Wraparound will be funded 100% by counties.
