### Crafting our Approach to Focus Area #1 – Tobacco Free Living (Debra Oto-Kent and Wendy Petko)

#### CDC and HSC Non-negotiables

- 5% reduction in death and disability due to tobacco use
- Create conditions for positive impact in the 15 selected zip codes

#### Setting the Stage with Policy Scan and Community Health Assessment Data

- What previous and/or current policy advocacy efforts have there been in the Sacramento region? (Prevention Institute)
- What do we know about tobacco use in the 15 zip codes? (Valley Vision)

### Policy Workgroup Recommendations – Carolyn Martin/Kimberly Bankston-Lee

- 1) Smoke-free multi-unit/family housing
- 2) Tobacco assessments and cessation procedures during medical intakes and treatment
- 3) Culturally and age-sensitive tobacco cessation and prevention services
