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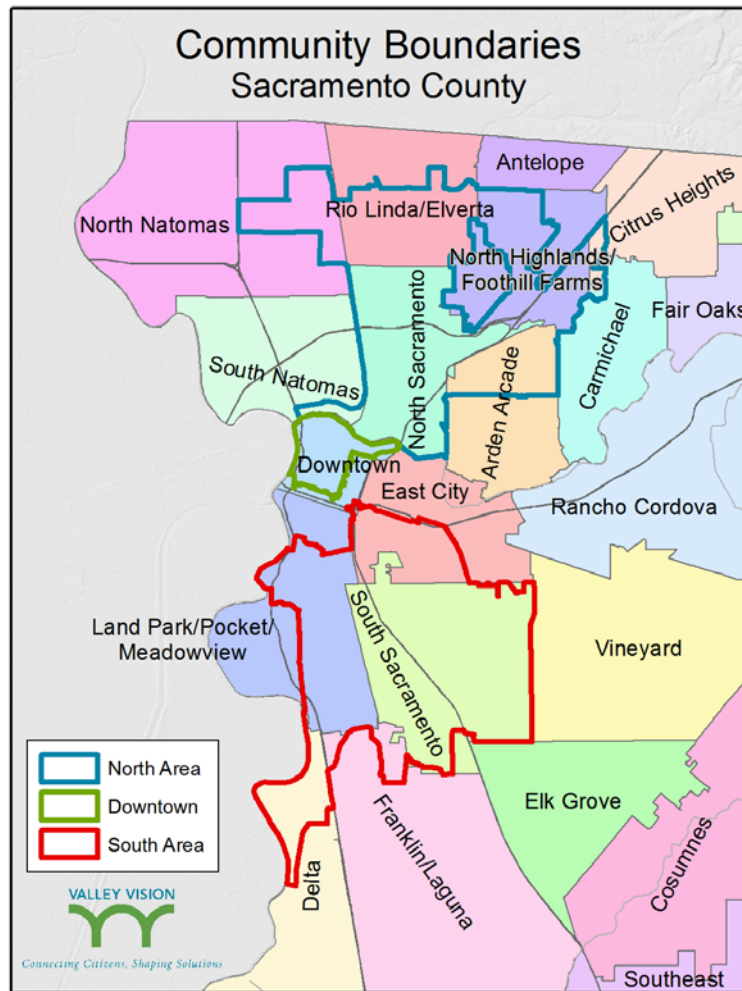
# Healthy Sacramento Coalition

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# HSC All-In Framework

- ❑ Starts Health Equity
  - ❑ Use Policy to Counteract Barriers and Systemic Exclusions
  - ❑ Use data, mapping and quantifiable measures to analyze how racial and ethnic groups are affected by Policy
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# HSC Policy Analysis Framework

A policy strategy tool that helps ensure that legislative bodies actively assess whether a policy's intent and impact are consistent with the Healthy Sacramento Coalition's expressed equity principle.
